Year 1 - Autumn 1 - 2017



Literacy

Phonics

 Year 1 will have 30 minutes of RWInc phonics, spellings and reading each morning.

Talk for Writing

• We are starting a new writing process across the school called 'Talk for Writing'. It's a story-telling process which helps children build a bank of narrative patterns they can use when creating their own stories. The children will have 1 hour of writing each day. This half term, Year 1 will read 'The Three Little Pigs' and 'Owl Babies' by Martin Waddell.

PSHE / RE

PSHE

 Year 1 will be learning to celebrate differences and discussing how they feel when they have to say goodbye to a loved one.

RE

Year 1 will learn about Christianity this term including the life and teachings of Jesus and shared customs including baptism.

Science, History, Geography, Art & Design, D&T and Computing

Science

- Year 1 will be learning about healthy and unhealthy foods and will be making a smoothie!
- They will also be learning about the senses.

Topic

- This half term's theme is SUPERHEROES! We will be focusing on Writing, PE, Art and Design, History and Music.
- Year 1 will be choreographing dance sequences, designing and making superhero masks, making a mascot using junk modelling and clay, and discussing how to keep safe in an emergency.
- Year 1 will be putting on a Superhero Catwalk Show for parents/carers during the last week of the half term!

Computing

 Year 1 will completing simple computer programs and using them to consolidate their learning in the other curriculum areas.

Mathematics

Maths

- Year 1 have started a new Maths scheme called 'Rising Stars'.
- They will be learning to count to 100, count back to subtract, add 1 and 2 to a 2-digit number, count in 10s, find halves and quarters of 2D shapes as well as describe their properties and order days of the week and months of the year.

Physical Education

- Year 1 will have specialist PE tuition this term for half of their PE allocation.
- Year 1 will be learning about different ways of moving and spatial awareness.
- They will play games such as stuck in the mud, follow the leader and banana split!

How to Support Your Child at Home

- Please read with your child EVERY DAY for at least 5-10 mins.
 Encourage him/her to point to each word and sound out any phonetic words he/she is unsure of and discuss each story's content.
- Please ensure they can get dressed/undressed independently.
